Scope

The BYTE project is developing a research and policy roadmap to help Europe capture a greater share of the big data market while using big data with social responsibility. This first of two roadmapping workshops will be devoted to developing the **BYTE research roadmap** with industry stakeholders, policy-makers, researchers, technical specialists, legal experts and academics. It will take place in Eindhoven right after the [European Data Forum 2016](#), on 1 July 2016, at the Evoluon.

The workshop will also see the foundation of the **BYTE Big Data Community**, in liaison with the Big Data Value Association (industry-led, private counterpart in the EC Big Data PPP). The Community will be one of the main outcomes of BYTE and will continue the project mission of investigating societal externalities of Big Data, until 2020 at least.
